UNFORGETTABLE P J contently stalked the pacesetter from the outside, bid nearing the quarter pole, gradually ranged up to the front runners during the run through the furlong grounds, drew even with a sixteenth to go, got a head down in front and inched away in the late stages, driving. PROUD GEORGE vied for the lead along the inside, was asked for run at the five-sixteenths pole, dug in with true grit and just failed in a valiant try. ALVITO buried along the inside, rode the rail for nearly a half, came wide for the stretch drive, settled into the six path at the top of the lane, and closed well to earn the show. FREUD'S DEBUT tracked the front runners from the pocket, vacated that position at the eighth pole, needed more. RIVERVIEW ROAD disputed the pace from the outside, weakened leaving the furlong grounds. YESTERDAY'S STORY chased from the outside and had no rally. FU PEGS BABY steadied after the start, dragged the rider into midpack, sat between rivals, under a firm hold until the half mile pole, continued between rivals around the far turn, came up empty for the stretch drive. NYKID TIME TO JAZZ raced along the outside, was urged on the turn, but failed to pick up interest. WONDER BEYOND

attempted to reach contention with a four wide move at the five-sixteenths pole, flattened out. MAKE MY MOVE three wide at the half mile pole, tired. UNDERTHESPOTLIGHT was never in contention. WIN THE DAY was never involved.
