DELACROIX argued the pace from the outside, responded when roused, dug in determinedly along the inside in the stretch and prevailed after a long drive. COALITION was unhurried early on, rallied four wide approaching the stretch and finished gamely outside but could not get by the winner. VICTORY CIRCLE was rated along early, came wide into the stretch and finished gamely outside. LEADING THE PARADE raced close up early, advanced three wide on the second turn and stayed on well in the stretch. SUAVE ACT was outrun early, came wide for the drive and offered a mild rally outside. DARGHAN (IRE) raced close up inside, put in a run along the inside entering the stretch and weakened late. CAPITAL PEAK argued the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch.
