LEMON DROP GAL raced close up along the inside, angled out in the stretch, responded when roused and drew clear under a drive. WINNING TOAST raced with the pace while three wide, drew clear, took a clear lead into deep stretch and continued on to hold the place. RESOUND (IRE) was outrun early, raced inside and was going well late. GAME FOR MORE was outrun early, rallied four wide on the turn and finished well outside. GREAT DEEP BAY chased the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. LOVE STRIKES tired after a half mile. JR.'S FREEDOM raced inside and had no rally. ALBANY COUNTY was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. PERFECT BLEND (GB) was checked on the backstretch and had no rally. MIRACLE MOMENT was rank early on and tired. GENEVIL tired after a half mile.
