Footnotes

WILLSBORO POINT was steadied during the early stages during the run on the backstretch, continued to sit well positioned along the inside while under a good hold, angled out for clearance in upper stretch, responded readily when asked, reached even terms with the leader with a sixteenth remaining and gradually increased his winning margin under good handling. SUMPWIN set an honest pace while facing mild pressure, entered the furlong grounds with a comfortable advantage, wasn't up to the task to stave off the winner's rally but continued on to the wire with good energy to protect place honors. STORMY MIRAGE under a good hold, finished well. DANCING TIN MAN outrun early while along the inside, swung out midway on the turn and came home belatedly. CHALOOK unhurried early, outfinished tiring ones. FOOTLOOSE MAN steadied between rivals and lacked the needed stretch response. ROMP (ARG) raced four wide and had no rally. PERSONAL GOOD steadied early, was a forward factor for six furlongs and tired. SAINT BARR pressed the pace from the outside, checked while tiring midway on the turn. RED DEMON had a wide trip and tired.
