Footnotes

DEPUTYVILLE checked at the start, raced well back for a half, moved out on the far turn, rallied four wide leaving the turn, angled to the inside in upper stretch, rallied between horses in midstretch then close late while drifting out to prevail after a long drive. EON pressed the pace from outside, took the lead midway on the turn, opened a clear advantage in midstretch but couldn't withstand the winner's late charge. HOIST THE GALA was outrun for a half, swung four wide while gaining at the quarter pole and finished willingly in the middle of the track. ELTISH STAR was reserved for a half, split horses on the far turn, swung four wide at the quarter pole and flattened out. DISTANT POINT chased three wide for five furlongs and faded. HEDGEFUND INVESTOR was used up setting the pace along the inside. CHIEF TASHMO raced in the middle of the pack in the two path and gave way on the turn.
