EIRE'S RUN set the pace on the rail, opened a clear advantage in upper stretch and drew away under right hand urging. FORTUNATE RUN saved ground for five furlongs, waited inside on the turn, angled out at the quarter pole and finished willingly to best the others. GAME TOKEN was reserved for a half, closed the gap midway on the turn, swung four wide while rallying in upper stretch and flattened out. MERLIN BAY checked after being pinched back at the start, was outrun for six furlongs, angled out in upper stretch and rallied belatedly. NEXT DAY checked after a slow start then saved ground while trailing most of the way. COALTOWN LEGEND pressed the pace from outside and gave way in upper stretch. GOODBYEANDGOODLUCK raced in hand along the backstretch, angled three wide and faltered on the turn.
