MISSION APPROVED off to a sharp start, quickly assumed the lead, was swung over to the inside in time for the opening turn, set the pace, well rated and loosely pressed, felt some pressure for the initial time approaching the quarter pole, shook free under steady hand encouragement from that station to the eighth pole, emerged from the furlong grounds holding his biggest advantage, was put to much stronger handling for the final furlong and held sway. BIM BAM gradually angled over to the hedge after leaving the starting gate, took up residence along the hedge, tracked the pacesetter from there, with the rider sitting atop with a firm hold on the reins, continued to bide time until leaving the five-sixteenths pole, was set down to a hard drive turning for home, vacated the inside in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, finished with good energy to secure the place. GIO PONTI placed under a snug hold, sat well reserved towards the hedge, patiently bided time for nearly a mile, was given some rein late on the far turn and immediately picked up interest, angled sharply four wide into the stretch for optimal racing clearance, kicked in with a strong response after completing the move, charged down the center of the course belatedly en route for the show. AL KHALI unhurried off the inside, was asked for a response coming to the five-sixteenths pole, got out finished. BOLD HAWK three wide around the far turn, lacked the necessary stretch response. STRAIGHT STORY was rated prompting the pacesetter from the two path, bided time for the opening three-quarters, turned up the pressure on the top one as that pair headed for the top of the stretch, but soon backed away. WINDWARD ISLANDS drafted behind VISCOUNT NELSON three wide entering the backstretch, continued to race off the inside thereafter and failed to reach a contending position. VISCOUNT NELSON left the opening turn from the three path, continued from there down the backstretch and around the second bend, was set to a drive approaching the five-sixteenths pole in prior to issuing a challenge for the front, flattened out. PRINCE WILL I AM placed four wide midpoint on the far turn, was put to a prolonged drive and tired.
