DR. W sat reserved in the pocket, angled outward entering the stretch, closed readily on the front runners, struck the front in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole and kicked clear. SUMFUN made an inside run on the turn, poked a head in front at the eighth pole, clung tenaciously to it before relinquishing with about a

sixteenth to go, held well to preserve the place. SCORPER swung four wide into the stretch, displayed a good kick en route for the show. CLOSE TO THE VEST underwent a three wide pursuit and flattened out. EVER A FRIEND lacked the necessary stretch response. SAINTS ALIVE vied inside and gave way. MITIGATION three wide upper stretch, had no rally. ONZAIN cut the corner, but failed to gain ground appreciably. RUSSIAN SAGE disputed the pace from the outside until the midstretch and faltered. KEECHI BULLET five wide into the lane, failed to menace. SLY in hand after the break, was outrun. KINGSDALE OCEAN (IRE) offered little.
