Footnotes

AUGUST OSAGE was hand urged into a forward position leaving the starting gate, pressed between rivals down the backstretch, around the turn and through the furlong grounds, poked a head in front hitting the eighth pole, then dug in gamely to edge away. VOYLES assumed a forward spot soon after the start, raced three to four wide around the turn, disputing the pace with another threesome, continued to battle hard after entering the stretch, began to drop back slightly from the top one departing the furlong grounds, but finished with good determination to garner place honors. NOBLE DOSS took the overland route, was the outmost member of a contentious pace dispute, held gamely to the end, but had to settle for show honors. NOT NOW ASHLEY hustled away from the gate, was unable to shake loose early, alternated between the rail and the two path, but while always the innermost combatant during a four way pace battle, held his ground stubbornly before weakening in the last sixteenth. CRUSHING away well from the starting gate, appeared a bit anxious and slow to rate kindly, as the rider tried to avoid the early pace fight, was finally steadied and eased back near the five-eighths pole, got going soon afterwards, was in the midst of making a menacing inside run coming to midpoint on the turn, when forced to steady once more, this time after being in tight quarters, lost some ground and momentum, tried to get going again, angled four wide into upper stretch, but had little left to offer by this stage of the race. WANSTEAD placed six wide for the stretch drive, had no kick. BOLD CHOICE raced along the outside and was outrun. MEADOW CAT got off behind the field, after breaking a bit awkwardly, was off the inside for most of the running and failed to reach a contending position.
