JUSTIN PHILLIP vied outside TRAVELIN MAN for command during the opening stages, shook free after completing a quarter, cut the fractions, well rated in the two path until three-sixteenths pole, was let out just past that station, spurted away to a commanding advantage during the next sixteenth, held sway, intermittently urged the remainder of the way. J J'S LUCKY TRAIN raced along the outside, was put to a prolonged drive and got up for the place. ARCH TRAVELER tucked along the rail soon after the start, was under a full drive cutting the corner into the stretch, drifted outward under hand encouragement soon afterwards, felt the stick right handed and resumed a truer course, came outward a second time while narrowing the gap, leaving the furlong grounds, requiring some more attention from the right side to counteract, continued onward, drifted outward yet one final time in the late stages, and missed second. TRAVELIN MAN dueled briefly with the winner down the backstretch, lost contact with that one approaching the half mile pole, swung into the three path for another try but wasn't up to the task. DERIVATIVE raced along the outside, was urged on the turn and tired.
