SENSIBLY CHIC bobbled at the start, raced close up outside, rallied three wide nearing the stretch, responded when roused and drew away late. BANK AUDIT was outrun early, raced inside on the turn, altered course to the outside in upper stretch and finished gamely. ENDER'S SISTER was hustled up inside, contested the pace along the inside and weakened on the rail in the stretch. BALDOMERA was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and finished well outside. EMERALD EARRINGS raced in hand while four wide and had no response when roused. SMOKEY GLACKEN contested the pace from the outside and tired in the final furlong. FORTY MOVES raced between rivals while three wide and had no response when roused. FRIENDLY MICHELLE showed speed while between rivals and was finished early. TRACI GIRL was outrun early, raced five wide on the turn and tired in the stretch.
