TWO SUSANS carried inward slightly by ROSIE'S SONG at the start, went on to make light contact with BILEAPS AND BOUNDS as a result, raced in midpack from off the inside, got put to some encouragement spinning four wide into the stretch, kicked into her best stride nearing the furlong marker, charged at the leader with good energy and collared that opponent in the shadow of the finish line. CARLA SWEETREVENGE took up the role of primary pursuer in the early stages, contently prompted the pacesetter from the two path for nearly a half, ranged up and issued a successful challenge to lead the field into the stretch, was asked for some run and scampered away to her biggest advantage during the ensuing furlong, had the lead chopped down chunks at a time by the winner and got nipped. ROSIE'S SONG broke inward, initiating a minor bumping incident, was put to some hand urging en route to securing a forward position, underwent a four wide pursuit on the turn, kept to light encouragement while doing so, turned for home and was asked for more, failed to pick up speed noticeably and had to settle for the show. BUSTIN OUT ALLOVER chased tree wide, launched an abbreviated bid for command during the later stages of the run around the bend, failed to sustain it and backed away. PRIZE TAKER needed several attempts before getting loaded into the gate, had no major trouble departing it, raced slightly more than three wide on the turn, at times pulling on the left side of the bit, was given her cue entering the stretch, drifted out a couple of paths while racing through the furlong grounds, failed to make an impact. DEAREST DIXIE under some urging tracking the front runners while sitting a loose pocket, faltered. BILEAPS AND BOUNDS brushed at the start, saved ground to no avail. LIGHT WEIGHT showed the way from the inside, gave way readily once put to the test nearing the quarter pole.
