### Footnotes

STORM SHOWERS steadied after being pinched back at the start, raced in traffic at the half mile pole, swung out entering the stretch and finished strongly in the middle of the track. BRAMPTON raced just off the early pace, rallied four wide on the turn, drew even for the lead in deep stretch but couldn't hold the winner safe. PIN TURN (GB) pressed three wide, gained a slim lead in midstretch and was caught late. STRATEGIC MISSILE steadied in traffic on the far turn, was shuffled back on the turn and fought back late between horses. WICKED RAVNINA raced just off the pace, split horses in upper stretch and finished willingly. ATLANTIC BEAUTY set the pace on the rail and tired. LONG GONE steadied between horses at the half mile pole, raced in traffic at the quarter pole and lacked a late response. AMIRAHY raced in traffic on the backstretch then saved ground to no avail. THE CHILD EMPRESS took up early and was never close thereafter. TROUBLE N MIND never reached contention. GLORY WIT A STORY was never close after breaking poorly.
