Footnotes

FORWARD MARCH set the pace from just off the inside under light hand urging, was let out in earnest at the quarter pole, edged away through to the eighth pole, saw that margin cut into late on while kept busy to score safely. HANGOVER KID broke out at the start and was corrected before any contact could be made with his outside rival, raced towards the rear until commencing a four wide bid from the seven-sixteenths, moved to be within striking distance at the head of the lane, offered up a mild bid when cutting into the winner's margin in the late stages while safe for the place. MOST HAPPY FELLA under light coaxing while pressing three wide, was let out while between foes at the quarter pole, ran on but could make no headway late on through the stretch while well clear for the show. FLAMIN' HOT tracked the front down along the inside, cut the corner into the stretch under a drive and tired. ROGUE VICTORY unhurried in the early going, came under a prolonged drive just past the seven-sixteenths and never menaced.
