Footnotes

VOTER left the backstretch the widest of the front runners and pressed the issue towards the three path, made a successful challenge for command coming to the quarter pole, under some encouragement, but less so than the rival being displaced, entered the stretch holding a comfortable advantage and got set down, extended the margin proceeding his way down the stretch, getting geared down leaving the sixteenth pole. L. C. SLEEPY off the inside, rallied for the place. FAST GRIEVANCE put to some urging early down the backstretch, saved ground for nearly a half, fanned five wide into upper stretch and came home belatedly for the show. STORIESINTHEDARK chased three wide and tired. VERVEITUP vied for the lead from the two path, and faltered. WINLOC'S JOHN LEE argued for command from the inside until the three-eighths pole before backing away.
