IRON DEPUTY was hustled to the front, set the pace while in hand, drew clear when asked, dug in gamely in the stretch and remained clear under a steady drive. VOLPONI came away well, raced close up inside, rallied inside nearing the stretch, angled out in upper stretch and finished gamely. SAARLAND raced with the pace while three wide and had no response when roused. EVENING ATTIRE was outrun early, put in a run along the inside on the turn and had little left for the stretch drive. HARLAN'S HOLIDAY broke slowly, was urged along outside, raced four wide and tired in the stretch. DUE TO A SEVERE ELECTRICAL THUNDERSTORM, THIS RACE WAS HAND-TIMED.
