TROPHY WIFE was briefly hustled away from the starting gate to secure a forward post, left the backstretch three wide and gave chase on the front runners, got let out a notch early on the turn, left the five-sixteenths pole under a brisk hand ride, spun into the lane and went for the lead in earnest, was outermost of three vying for command during the run through the furlong grounds, wrested it away from CRAFTY PUSH past the eighth pole and shook free, got geared down in the late stages, crossing the finish line under mild hand encouragement. CRAFTY PUSH made the front shortly after the start, had UNRIVALED SCORE draw on even terms nearing the end of the backstretch, argued for control with that opponent, lightly coaxed to maintain interest, had the eventual winner arrive on the scene by the quarter pole yet remained unasked for run until near the three-sixteenths marker, fought with a pair of rivals during the initial portion of the stretch drive, continued the battle one on one with TROPHY WIFE when the middle partner of the fight backed away, relinquished before reaching the sixteenth pole, held on well for the place. UNRIVALED SCORE latched on to the runner up approaching the half mile pole, raced heads with that rival around the turn, continued the pursuit, but now from between foes from upper to midstretch, failed to keep pace and weakened into the show slot. STAR LILLIE was asked for run while racing on the turn, left the rail in midstretch, lacked the necessary response. JAYEZAA raced along the outside, was asked for a response by midpoint on the turn, but offered none. STREET DREAMS three wide and roused departing the backstretch, folded.
