ASSOCIATE got off a beat slowly, raced three wide while wedged between rivals for most of the way around the bend, commenced the stretch drive one path wider with SPIN OUT bouncing off after making a futile attempt to angle outward, was the widest of the fighting foursome to reach the eighth pole in close proximity of each other, grabbed command soon afterwards and edged away, crossing the finish line under hand urging. SAINT OF SAINTS contested the pace with DANGEROUS TRICK while racing along the outside, forged his way to a narrow advantage arriving at the furlong marker, but with a trio of opponents still in the thick of things, yielded to the top one but dug in stubbornly to preserve the place. SPIN OUT was put to a snug hold after allowed to rush up in the early stages into a forward position, squeezed his way into the two path at the half mile pole, remained on hold during the run around the bend, entered the stretch lacking room to angle outward but with DANGEROUS TRICK having drifted into the two path at this point, was taken over to the newly-created rail passageway, moved up menacingly, got outfinished in the last eighth. DANGEROUS TRICK out broke the field to grab the early advantage and was tucked over to the rail, fought with SAINT OF SAINTS to maintain the lead, going head to head with that rival on the turn, arrived at the quarter pole facing heavy pressure, drifted into the two path in upper stretch, leaving the inside exposed, relinquished just before reaching the furlong marker and steadily tired. GREEN MONSTER chased the pace combatants four wide on the turn, folded.
