SAN PABLO coaxed three wide within aim of the front, got set down continuing three wide for home confronting MUCHO MACHO MAN now on the lead as HYMN BOOK ranged up inside, took command nearing the eighth pole, edged away under a drive to prevail drifting in under off sided stick work in the final eighth. HYMN BOOK allowed to settle, tracked the pace from just off the inside, got placed to light coaxing to take closer order at the half mile pole, angled to cut the corner in front of the weakening SOVEREIGN DEFAULT through a narrow gap roused, rallied challenging inside with good energy to garner the place honors. MUCHO MACHO MAN away well, was forwardly placed two to three wide attending the leader in hand, came under urging at the five-sixteenths taking command at that station and inching away briefly to the quarter pole, got confronted by a pair on either side straightened for home, was displaced nearing the eighth pole, kept on with good energy through to the wire well clear of the rest. SOVEREIGN DEFAULT on the pace along the inside in hand patiently handled while accompanied to the outside, came under a ride three furlongs out as the pressure intensified, got headed at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into the stretch and weakened in the drive. ISN'T HE PERFECT broke in a step at the start and was corrected, raced three to four wide within range early on, came under urging three furlongs out beginning to lose ground on the field, lost contact through the latter portion of the turn and was eased through the final furlong.
