CONCEALED broke open the gate prior to the start, broke in at the start squeezing RICE AND BEANS out between foes, chased two to three wide in pursuit under light coaxing, got roused at the five-sixteenths, steadily rallied through the lane, collared the leader a sixteenth out and inched away to prevail safe. THERAPY dueled inside from the get go lightly coaxed along, shook away from her main pace foe nearing the quarter pole, dug in to maintain her advantage a furlong out, got collared a sixteenth from home, kept on mildly safe for the place. GOING GOING GONE chased three wide from the rear ridden along from midway on the turn, offered up a mild kick for the show honors clear of the rest. AMAZING ABBY broke in at the start under hustling, dueled from just off the inside through the turn urged along, got shaken off nearing the quarter pole and faltered. RICE AND BEANS taken in hand briefly when squeezed between foes at the start, chased from just off the inside coaxed along, angled four wide in upper stretch offering no response and weakened in the drive.
