INDIAN CARD contested the pace while three wide, drew clear into the stretch and remained clear under a drive. LIGHT UP THE SKY was outrun early, raced four wide and was going well outside late. LAKE DANZIG was outrun early, rallied three wide and finished gamely. IRISH ROAD was bumped at the start, contested the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. CENTER raced inside and had no response when roused. PARHELION (GER) was bumped at the start, chased the pace along the inside and lacked a rally. WHATS WHAT chased the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. TELL J was bumped at the start, contested the pace while between rivals and tired. ERIN'S STORM was bumped at the start and tired after showing brief speed.
