KATY NOW away well, cleared the field soon after the break to establish control, rated kindly in the two path, was put to test coming to the quarter pole, got called upon seconds before the closest pursuer did, as that pair headed into the stretch, showed good determination to turn that foe back. ASK THE MOON three wide, stalked the top one under a snug hold until the seven-sixteenths pole, ranged up to increase the pressure late on the turn, was called for run almost simultaneously with the winner, gained gradually during the last eighth, but wasn't good enough. ARENA ELVIRA settled along the inside early, moved up after completing the opening quarter, contently tracked the front runner during the run around the bend, was under encouragement cutting the corner into the lane, and rallied willingly enough to secure the show. MINERALOGIST placed in the two path at the half mile pole, tired. AILALEA was off sluggishly after ducking inward at the start, rushed up after being allowed to settle into stride, reached midpack and was taken well to the outside, appeared rank, fighting with the bit for most of the way down the backstretch, entered the turn from the four path, continued widest of all, was put to a drive by midpoint and tired.
