**Footnotes**

CLEAR ATTEMPT assumed a forward position soon after the start, was placed under a good hold and contently stalked the pacesetter, continued along on the same scenario for almost a mile, moved up to apply pressure on the leader, turned for home on nearly even terms and got called upon, needed only a few strides into the stretch run to take over, kicked clear during the remainder of the way through the furlong grounds, felt the runner up's presence in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, offered good resistance to that one and held safe. COLOSSAL GIFT saved ground with the rider sitting with a snug hold on the reins, was eased off the hedge midway on the far turn, swung three wide into the stretch and was put to encouragement, was pulled off EMPIRICIST in upper stretch, resumed his rally, finished with good energy to garner place honors. EMPIRICIST three wide approaching the opening bend, bumped lightly with TOCCE'T'S IM,AGE before working his way past that one to take over the two path by midpoint, sat reserved from there until the quarter pole, was asked for a response entering the stretch and got out finished. IMAGING in a bit tight off rivals a few strides out of the starting gate, was steadied and taken back, raced rankly, proving to be slow to rate, acted more professionally upon reaching the backstretch, remained unhurried until late on the far turn, swung three wide into the stretch but lacked the necessary response. BONDED (IRE) along the inside, was well rated until the quarter pole, felt pressure for the initial time at that station and succumbed. POPPLESTONE tracked along the inside, was given some rein at the three-eighths pole, but failed to respond. HALEFELLOW WELLMET offered little. TOCCE'T'S IMAGE bumped lightly with EMPIRICIST early on the first turn, raced along the outside and was through after completing three-quarters.
