TRULY DEVOTED lightly hand urged leaving the starting gate, quickly took control, was rated on a loosely-contested lead, placed at a slight distance from off the rail, began to edge away from more energetically-handed pursuers during the later stages of the run around the bend, entered the stretch and was roused, drew off to a lengthy score while drifting outward. SUMMER FLICK gave chase on the winner from the two path, left the backstretch under some encouragement, was under a fervent drive by midpoint, proved no match, but held on well enough for the place. WORLD PREMIER underwent a three wide pursuit and proved no match for either of the top two finishers. AFRICAN JAZZ took the inside route, was under a drive by the five-sixteenths pole, tired. RUM TILL I DIE outrun for three-quarters, swung five wide into upper stretch, improved position by weak and tired ones. TATOO ME three to four wide on the turn, folded. DONNA'S SANDEE along the outside, came under encouragement at the half mile pole, fell back steadily on the turn, ducked over to the rail nearing the quarter pole, cut the corner into the stretch and continued to retreat.
