ZIVO urged from midpack from the half mile pole while four wide through the turn, steadily progressed on the front to move into contention nearing the quarter pole, collared the front just past the three-sixteenths, fought with that rival heads apart to the sixteenth marker before edging away kept busy to the end. THE KENOSHA KID away well, set the pace from the two path, repulsed a bid for command from FIVE CARD DRAW nearing the three-eighths pole, came under urging soon after nearing the five-sixteenths, got confronted by the eventual winner at the head of the lane, displaced at the three-sixteenths, fought on until the final sixteenth when unable to keep pace with the top one while well clear for the place honors and second best. BAKE SHOP three wide in close pursuit, steadily lost some position and ground through the turn as a product of patient handling, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths to pick it up, swung three wide for home, offered up a mild kick through the lane for show honors while never threatening the top. DOWNGOESFRAZIER raced in midpack between rivals, made a three to four wide bid through the turn from the three-eighths pole following the eventual winner, swung three wide for home, shifted in one path at the three-sixteenths, flattened out unable to sustain the move in the final eighth while well clear for the last major share. MONEYINYOUR POCKET broke out at the start and was corrected, was outrun in the initial going, came under a drive at the three-eighths, passed tired rivals in the lane. FIVE CARD DRAW off a beat slow, ranged up to bid for command at the seven-sixteenths, got repulsed by the leader, came under urging nearing the five-sixteenths and tired. MASTER CIP veered in sharply at the start into the gap of the clubhouse turn and had to be maneuvered back on course, tracked the pace inside under a good hold until the half mile pole, came under a prolonged drive at that station and stopped.
