SAY MR. SANDMAN three to four wide in close pursuit through the turn, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, displaced the leader just as they straightened for home, drew clear through the stretch under a drive kept busy to the end. BACK CATCHA ERIC tracked the front inside from just off the pace, came under urging at the three-eighths, progressed on the front and shifted to be three wide at the quarter pole, ran on no match for the top one while second best. RIVER RON midpack early on, came under encouragement from the two path turning for home, displayed a mild kick through the lane to just get up and procure the show honors. KARAKORUM HOLIDAY initially just off the leader, moved to press the pace from the seven-sixteenths pole while in the two path, inherited the lead from the tiring pace setter nearing the quarter pole, was put to a drive at that station leading briefly until being straightened away, was overhauled at that juncture, remained prominent until the final eighth, drifted in while weakening at that station, safely garnered the last major share. NEW YORK NEW YORK chased the front while three wide towards the rear, ran greenly through the turn displaying subtle climbing action, and never reached contention. MISSILE NICK hustled from the start, set the pace inside under light hand urging, yielded the front readily nearing the quarter pole and faltered. WHO lunged at the break conceding two to three lengths to the front and trailed throughout.
