Footnotes

PARTLY MOCHA bumped at the start when FREUD'S DEBUT broke outwards, tracked the leader from the two path, shifted out three wide turning for home set down for the drive, collared the leader at the eighth pole, edged clear through the final furlong kept to task. FREUD'S DEBUT broke out at the start bumping the aforementioned rival before being taken off, sat just off the inside towards the rear, made steady progress on the front under coaxing from the five-sixteenths, continued just off the inside into the lane, kicked on with good energy late to be up for place honors while no threat to the winner. DEPARTURES well placed in the two path between foes in close range of the front, came under urging approaching the head of the stretch, swung three wide at that station in and behind the eventual winner, kicked home mildly for the show honors late on. RUDY RUDY RUDY sped off to the front just off the inside, came under urging at the quarter pole still off the inside, got confronted by the top one, battled briefly before yielding the front at the eighth pole, steadily weakened late on in the final sixteenth. LUIGI P chased the front from towards the rear while three to four wide through the turn, was pushed along from the five-sixteenths making up ground steadily, spun widest of all six wide into the stretch, offered up a mild kick through the lane while never threatening the front. A BOY NAMED EM towards the rear early on, saved ground throughout, cut the corner into the stretch under a drive, passed tired foes through the lane. DECESION POINT midpack while two to three wide, spun five wide for home under a drive and offered little. TURN UP THE MUSIC saved ground while in midpack throughout, cut the corner into the lane and offered no response. NONNO'S BOY just off the pace four wide in pursuit, was urged at the five-sixteenths, swung five wide in upper stretch and weakened. IT'S TRULY AHVEE three wide in close pursuit, was under a prolonged drive through

the turn from the seven-sixteenths, swung four wide at the quarter pole and tired.
