Footnotes

SHMOOZ TALKER grabbed command soon after the break and tucked along the inside, carved the pace, rated until the quarter pole, staved off all challengers down the lane under a drive to prove best. ORSONIAN prompted the winner from the two path, failed to dent into the margin after turning for home, held on well for the place. FISHERMAN'S WHARF well placed in the pocket, got outfinished. BECKHAM BEND between rivals on the turn, lacked the

necessary stretch response. KING ROCK underwent a ground-saving journey, steadied when in tight amongst rivals shortly after entering the turn, losing some momentum and ground as a result, got back going soon afterwards, flattened out in the final furlong. WASCALLY RABBIT chased three wide on the turn, was through after completing a half. CONGO roused while angling four wide at the five-sixteenths pole, mustered up a mild response to improve position. RECHARGED sneaked over to the rail in time for the run around the bend, was taken in hand, responding to SUPERSTELLA being steadied just past the half mile pole, cut the corner into the lane, was a few strides into the stretch drive before angling outward three wide, made no headway on the front runners. SUPER DOC three wide departing the backstretch, failed to menace. TIGER WILLIE raced along the outside and was outrun. ONZAIN off a beat slowly after tossing his head a split second or so before the field was sent off and running, trailed throughout.
