Footnotes

P J'S MAGICAL WINK grabbed the advantage shortly after the start, took up residence in the two path being pressed by a latched-on SWISS TART for nearly a half parked to her outside, began to edge away during the later stages of the run around the bend, entered the stretch and was given his cue, responded positively to arrive at the eighth pole holding his biggest advantage, began to drift outward in the late stages, with the rider attempting to counteract this by flashing the stick from the right side, held on safely. LAYSH LAYSH LAYSH was bumped after the start, raced along the outside, was two wide and set down at the midway point on the turn, swung four wide into the lane, came home with good energy down the center of the strip to garner the place. SWISS TART lunged outward making contact with STARSHIP CAPTAIN as a result, chased the winner three wide, got outfinished and had to settle for the show. CLASSIC R AND B rode the rail until halfway through the furlong grounds, vacated the premises to steer past a weakening rival and mustered up a mild response to mainly improve position. WHY BROADWAY was guided onto the inside route approaching the end of the backstretch, got set down cutting the corner into the lane, came up empty. STARSHIP CAPTAIN bumped from between rivals just of the starting gate, was four wide departing the backstretch, entered the stretch one path wider, tired. GUNFIGHTER underwent a three wide pursuit on the turn, folded.
