Footnotes

PROUD MAN settled in good position while saving ground, moved outside NAVESINK approaching the quarter pole, made a run to challenge in upper stretch, battled heads apart into deep stretch and prevailed in a hard drive; PROUD MAN was bleeding from the right hind leg in the winners circle following the race and was vanned off. PACKAGE STORE was reserved for a half, rallied along the inside midway on the turn, angled out in upper stretch then closed steadily but could not get up. NAVESINK rushed up to gain the early advantage, set the pace under pressure while saving ground along the backstretch, opened a clear advantage midway on the turn, dug in when challenged in upper stretch, fought gamely into deep stretch then yielded grudgingly. VOLPONI was unhurried for a half while saving ground, checked slightly while being shuffled back on the far turn, stayed on the rail rallying into the stretch then finished willingly along the inside. HARRISAND (FR) raced well back after breaking slowly, closed the gap on the turn, raced just outside VALPONI entering the stretch and improved her position with a mild late rally. WHITMORE'S CONN checked in traffic on the far turn, was never a factor. SIR BRIAN'S SWORD chased the leaders while three wide to the top of the stretch and steadily tired thereafter. RELUCTANT GROOM settled just off the early pace, raced within striking distance while five wide to the turn then lacked a further response. PERFECT STRANGER failed to threaten while racing wide. BERCHTESGADEN forced the pace between horses to the turn and gave way.
