EAVESDROPPER raced close up while three wide and finished well to earn the place award. NEW YORK PROSPECT chased the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. OUTSMART chased the pace along the inside and had no response when roused. GET SMARTER broke a bit awkwardly, ducked in after the start, raced very greenly and tired. EXTREME FIGHTER raced greenly along the inside and tired. CROUCHING TIGER raced inside and tired.
