BLUES STREET came away in good order, took up residence in the back of the pack, picked up interest nearing the half mile pole, was guided over to the outside, made a four wide sweep to reach a good striking distance, accomplishing the task with his own natural speed, continued to creep up to the front runners after entering the stretch, responded positively when given hie cue in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, emerged from the furlong grounds the new leader, then continued onward with good energy to preserve the decision. ASPHALT was unhurried off the inside in midpack, was forced to remain on hold, lacking suitable options from the five-sixteenths pole to the quarter pole, found clearance in upper stretch, made available by the weakening former pacesetter, altered course inward and took off in earnest, kicked in with good energy to loom briefly with an eighth to go, could not keep pace with the top one leaving that station, but finished willingly for the place. ALCOMATCH rated in the pocket until the five-sixteenths pole, finished well belatedly en route for the show. EVOLUTIONIST made a three wide run departing the starting gate to assume the role of stalker, moved up to pressure the leader after completing the opening half, grabbed a narrow lead late on the far turn, got called upon in upper stretch, relinquished soon afterwards, weakened in the last eighth. ALYARF was taken in hand after attempting to duck outward at the start, raced three wide around both turns, tired after going six furlongs. WISHFUL TOMCAT was well rated slightly off the hedge, set moderate fractions, got displaced by the five-sixteenths pole and steadily tired.
