COMPLIANCE OFFICER gave chase from afar early, began to pick up interest and cut into that opponent's edge during the later stages of the run around the bend, was called upon after settling into upper stretch, closed ground rapidly during the next furlong, had no sooner poked a head in front when confronted by the runner up, went head to head right down to the finish, displaying true grit to prevail. STRONG IMPACT four wide departing the backstretch, gained ground from midway on the turn, lost none of his momentum spinning wide into the lane, good hooked up in a duel with the winner just past the furlong marker, fought tenaciously but got denied. DRIVEN BY SOLAR urged entering the stretch, settled into the five path at the head of the stretch, then displayed a good kick en route for the show. CAN'T REFUSE saved ground on the turn, was already under a full drive by the five-sixteenths pole, and finished willingly for the last major award. CHERNOBYL'S HERO underwent a ground-saving journey and made no bids. TOCCO D'ORO sprinted clear early, turned for home still holding a comfortable advantage, got caught by the eighth pole and faltered. ZIP QUIK three wide at the half mile pole, tired. HOT MONEY well off the inside throughout, fanned six wide into upper stretch, had no offering.
