SHERRY BAY G. broke alertly and took up a forward position, disputed the pace outside CASEY PRINCESS, doing so from the three path a good portion down the backstretch and as well around the turn, drew alongside her nemesis after turning for home, battled intensely heads apart and gamely earned the decision. CAREY PRINCESS broke on top and remained with lead while making her way down the backstretch, made it over to the two path and chose to stay there for the run around the bend, argued for control with the top one, had the battle spill over into the stretch, only with the rider of each combatant having set down their mounts to a drive, raced on nearly even terms to the finish line but had to settle for the place. DESERT BLISS was placed into the two path shortly after the start, sat in midpack without making a move until the five-sixteenths pole, was put to encouragement and angled four wide at that station in preparation for the stretch run, found her best stride departing the furlong grounds, closing ground rapidly on a pair of front runners perhaps a bit softened by their own earlier efforts. CAPE COD CAROL was taken hold of twice a few strides out of the starting gate, in each instance shying away from DESERT BLISS as that one was settling into the two path, got going in short order and was guided into the three path, remained there until hearing the top

of the stretch, was maneuvered to be six wide by the three-sixteenths pole to gain optimal racing clearance, showed a good, but belatedly kick, to secure the last major award. PRINCESS JENNY coaxed in the four path on the turn, lacked a solid closing response. GALAXY JET forwardly placed along the outside for a half, had no rally. EUROSENSATION saved ground and was no factor. ZIPPY KITTY darted over to the inside after the start, tracked the front runners for a half before backing away. MATTIE'S WARRIOR took the overland route, folded. ESTHERS CLASSY LAS came out slightly initiating light contact with the nearest opponent, raced from off the inside and was outrun. STONE MAKER was lightly bumped at the start, lost contact with the field before reaching the end of the backstretch, was put to a protective hold and galloped over the finish line en route for the last minor share.
