Footnotes

RAISE THE FLAG sat reserved while taking the inside route, bided time until the quarter pole, was given her cue and responded positively, gained ground readily during the run through the furlong grounds, angled outward coming to the eighth pole, with no loss of momentum, continued onward, collaring the leader in the final seventy yards and edging away under a brisk hand ride. LILY THE PINK under a firm hold, grabbed the early advantage and tucked along the rail, rated kindly with an equally well rated GOLD EMPIRE latched on one path wider, remained under the same conditions until the nearing the quarter pole, felt intensified pressure from others in paths further to the outside and was soon asked for run, held her ground stubbornly from upper to deep stretch, yielded past the sixteenth pole to the winner but preserved the place. GOLD EMPIRE made a three wide run to take up the role of stalker, stayed glued outside the pacesetter while being rated along by the rider for just over three-quarters, reached the quarter pole with several pursuers in full flight and was switched over to a drive, battled hard down the lane but couldn't go by LILY THE PINK in a good effort nonetheless. COSMIC ENERGY sat under a firm hold tracking the front runners from the pocket, failed to fire appreciably when called upon for the stretch run. RIOLAMA took the inside route and launched a mild rail rally once in the stretch. CLARINDA strung out three wide on the turn, remained off the inside throughout, was roused while angling four wide at the five-sixteenths pole, failed to make headway on the front runners. INDY DREAMING lagged behind in the initial stages, was given some rein and unleashed a bold sweeping move from midpoint on the far turn, was forced to move wider a sixteenth down the road once CLARINDA launched a bid on her own, took the five path into the stretch and soon flattened out. DYNARAMA stumbled a few strides out of the starting gate, raced in midpack from off the rail, was placed five wide at the head of the stretch, had no rally. CERTAINTY appeared unappreciative of the rating tactics being applied by the rider for much of the opening half, being rank and offering fierce resistance on the bit, tipped into the three path midway down the backstretch, went about more calmly after the maneuver, although still pulling on the bit slightly, stalked the pacesetter until the quarter pole and gave way.
