DODGING chased the runaway leader from afar during the opening half, closed the gap upon reaching the far turn, remained on hold, stuck behind a weakening STAR DISTINCTION, boxed in from the five-sixteenths marker to the quarter pole, was put to encouragement and angled four wide for freedom spinning into the lane, joined up with the front runners at the sixteenth pole, dueled with the runner up from there to the wire and gamely proved best. MONASTIR unhurried for the opening stages, picked up the pace during the run around the far turn, was asked for run spinning into the lane, fought his way to a narrow lead past the eighth pole, had an intense duel with the eventual winner begin about two jumps later, fell as much as a neck behind in the late stages before staging a comeback that fell a whisker short of re claiming the advantage. EAST INDIES contently stalked from long distance down the backstretch, closed the deficit rapidly leaving the half mile pole, took over with a three wide challenge coming to the five-sixteenths pole and was soon let out, continued to fight for the front until the vicinity of the sixteenth pole before weakening into the show slot. R J HOPE outrun for three quarters, had no

rally. LAUNCH N RELAUNCH lacked the needed response. LOVE SHACK (IRE) three wide until the five-sixteenths pole, departed that station from the four path, flattened out. WISHINGONADREAM tracked the loose pacesetter from the rail, made a run to go past the previously mentioned rival as EAST INDIES was making his move two paths further to the outside, battled for command until mid lane then weakened. STAR DISTINCTION spurted away from the competition under his own power, raced unopposed in the two path until leaving the midway point on the full turn, felt the presence of the herd reeling his in, got overhauled by a pair, one from the rail and the other from the three path, remained fairly prominent despite being slightly leg weary until midstretch then backed away. GAMBLIN FEVER saved ground, was checked while rank coming to the half mile pole, failed to get motivated when put to the whip a furlong down the road and tired. ELDER SKATESMAN lagged behind taking the inside route and was always outrun.
