DEFINE tracked the pace along the inside, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, angled three wide into upper stretch, rallied steadily gaining on the front pair, took over a sixteenth out inching away to prevail over a late closing pair outside. REGGIE D saved ground at the rear through the turn, came under urging three furlongs out, angled five wide at the quarter pole, kicked on belatedly into contention in the final sixteenth and just procured the place. VEE'S ACCOLADE just off the inside towards the rear urged from the three-eighths pole, cut the corner into the stretch, angled out two paths at the three-sixteenths, offered up a mild kick for the show. LUCCI THE LION hustled from the start, was on the pace down along the inside to the nine-sixteenths, drifted out to the three path for the run around the turn, got confronted along the inside and came under a ride at the five-sixteenths shifting in path to look his foe in the eye, lost the lead at the head of the stretch, dug in battling head to head with that foe until displaced in tandem by the eventual winner a sixteenth out then weakened in the late stages while able to garner the last major share. AUGUST OSAGE just off the pace just off the inside, challenged for the front lightly coaxed at the five-sixteenths as the leader remained three wide, shifted to the rail nearing the quarter pole, cut the corner into the lead roused for the stretch drive, fought head to head with the aforementioned rival through until displaced a sixteenth out and weakened late on. PROHIBITION three wide in pursuit of the front from mid pack, came under encouragement three furlongs out, offered no response and tired in the drive. TOO MUCH TALK hustled from the gate to be forwardly placed, chased four wide through the turn urged from midway, faded in the latter portion nearing the quarter pole and tired in the stretch.
