Footnotes

ZIP UP settled two to three wide just off the pace, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, ranged up to challenge at the quarter pole set down for the stretch drive, rallied fighting head to head taking command a furlong out while trying to get in greenly, inched away under a drive to prevail. CALLANA on the pace inside in hand, came under pressure nearing the quarter pole and got set down at that station in response, battled stubbornly with the aforementioned rival through to the eighth pole when headed, held well after being shaken off inside the sixteenth marker to just garner the place. EGOT broke in at the start and was corrected, settled just off the pace along the hedge, remained patiently handled in behind rivals until set down cutting the corner into the stretch, offered up a mild kick for the show. CELTIC ARCH just off the inside towards the rear, shifted out to be four wide commencing encouragement three furlongs out, continued four wide for home, kicked on with good late foot for the last major share. GIANT'S JEWEL tracked the front just off the inside, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths, had the eventual winner tighten up her lane as she ranged up nearing the quarter pole from the outside, was forced to briefly steady between foes losing some momentum, continued the drive once clear offering up a mild kick for through the stretch. NEOLEXIA two to three wide towards the rear, angled four wide for home under a drive and passed tired rivals in the stretch. GLENWOOD PINES three to four deep in mid pack, came under coaxing from the half mile pole, shifted five wide midway on the far turn placed to a drive and weakened in the stretch. RUTHIE BLUE EYES just off the inside in mid pack, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide for home and weakened. WINNER'S LEGACY forwardly placed inside unhurried early on, gradually faded losing position through the turn, got roused at the five-sixteenths and tired. SEDUCTIVE CHARM just off the inside in mid pack, shifted four wide at the three-eighths commencing a bid, advanced into prominence nearing the quarter

pole, swung four wide for home, ran on to the eighth pole before tiring in the final furlong. TREQQER three to four wide early on towards the rear, took the overland route through the turn ridden along from the five-sixteenths and made no impact.
