COUNTRY HIDEAWAY, unhurried outside early on, advanced four wide on the turn, took over and drew clear when roused and was ridden out to the finish. TOMISUE'S PLEASURE, close up early, split rivals on the turn, came wide for the drive and finished gamely to be second best. MINISTORM raced greenly along the inside, altered course to the outside in upper stretch and finished with good interest. CALL NINE ONE ONE, close up outside, rallied three wide on the turn, could not handle the winner in upper stretch and faded in the final furlong. MINBAR, bumped at the start, raced wide and lacked a rally. GOLD STREAMER chased the pace along the rail and tired in the stretch. RICHMOND REBEL raced five wide and tired badly. KNOW THE FACTS, bumped at the start and put to the whip for the lead, stopped after a half mile. COMMENTARY showed speed for a half mile and tired badly.
