\$1,000 to enter, starters to receive a \$750 rebate. The added money and all fees to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Weight 123 lbs.

Non-winners of a sweepstakes on the turf, allowed 3 lbs. Four Races, 5 lbs. Three Races, 7 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter and restricted allowance races not considered in allowances). GIMME CREDIT raced between rivals while in hand early, angled out in upper stretch, accelerated quickly when asked, finished strongly from the outside and was going away late. FIRST WORD raced close up early along the inside, rallied three wide into the stretch, led into deep stretch, but had no answer for the winner and held on for the place. DEFER was outrun early, rallied four wide approaching the stretch and finished well outside. SABRE BABY was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and was going well late. BARON VON TAP raced close up while three wide and lacked a rally. MATHEMATICIAN (IRE) pressed the pace from the outside and tired in the final furlong. RETRIBUTION was hustled to the front, set the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. MUSEEB raced inside and had no response when roused.
