### Footnotes

ROLLERS dueled along the inside for a half, shook loose when struck once with the whip in upper stretch and drew off under a vigorous hand ride. DIGGER pressed the winner from outside into upper stretch and held well to best the others. EXCESS CAPITAL steadied in traffic at the half mile pole, raced between horses on the turn and rallied mildly to gain a share. LAYSH LAYSH LAYSH hit the side of the gate after breaking slowly, was outrun for a half, circled four wide and failed to threaten with a mild late run from outside. EXECUTIVE FLEET saved ground just behind the leaders for a half and steadily tired thereafter. NEW MEMBER was outrun early, gained three wide to reach contention on the turn and flattened out. MUCHO MACHO broke slowly and was never close thereafter while saving ground.
