Footnotes

MR MAGENTA the last to leave the starting gate, powered past the field under his own courage to a forward position, pressed the pacesetter from the two path, bid when ready during the late stages of the run around the bend, responded positively once given his cue, poked a head in front at the eighth pole, then kicked clear driving. BRAVO ROMEO was lightly urged to grab the early lead, carved the pace from the inside, was put to the test by the top one late on the turn, offered good resistance during the ensuing furlong, lost the lead at the furlong marker, but showed good determination to fend off DANCE FLOOR MANIAC to preserve the place. DANCE FLOOR MANIAC rode the pocket until the quarter pole, was under a drive before reaching the head of the stretch, angled outward but lacked the necessary response. HALF METAL JACKET placed three wide at the three-eighths pole, was asked for some run but came up empty, then was vanned off after the finish. NO QUESTIONS raced along the outside, was called upon at the five-sixteenths pole, but failed to gain ground appreciably. KING RUSH three wide, trailed.
