BE BULLISH broke running, was soon joined by SPIRIT OF COCHISE, went head to head with that opponent from the half mile pole to the five-sixteenths pole before losing contact, angled outward for another go at the previously mentioned rival, drifted outward in several stages, in each instance appearing to shy away before being struck left handed, for a total of three times in all, staged a gallant comeback to regain the lead and drew clear. SPIRIT OF COCHISE contested the pace from the two path, shook free of the top one leaving the five-sixteenths pole, came under pressure once more from that same foe soon afterwards, and gave in. FRAZIL raced along the outside, was urged on the turn, but could make no headway on the first two finishers. STORMIN BUD three wide off an ongoing pace dispute, proved no match for the top twosome.
