G. A. EMPRESS unhurried at the rear while saving ground, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled out swinging six wide with a wall of horses to her inside, unleashed a good kick down the center of the course, surged up late to just get up on the line. GLORY IN MOTION raced three to four wide in

midpack, was pushed along from the three-eighths pole, got set down in earnest at the head of the lane spinning four wide, collared the leader inside the final sixteenth with a host of late charging rivals displaying good kick, got nailed on the line and settled for place honors. TONIGAIL three to four wide towards the rear, was put to encouragement swinging four wide for home, kicked on with good energy through the lane arriving on the scene in the late stages but was outfinished while safely garnering the show. BLUE GRASS MUSIC towards the rear in reserve, swung four wide upper stretch, offered up a mild kick while being out kicked for the top spots and along safe for the last major share. HIGH ALPINE away alertly, pursued the front three wide moving into closer range through the turn, swung three wide for home, was in contention for the top spots until the late stages when flattening out. TO THE POINT (ARG) attended the pace while two to three wide, took over the lead at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into the lane under a drive, edged away to a good lead by the eighth pole, weakened in the late stages yielding the front readily just inside the sixteenth marker. TUTTI VA BENE tracked the pace inside, was ridden along from the seven-sixteenths, remained prominent until the final eighth and weakened. HARBOR SPIRIT saved ground initially towards the rear, made steady positional progress to midpack, was set down at the top of the lane and made no late headway. IN HER HEY DAY hustled from the gate, set the pace from the two path under light coaxing, was displaced on the front at the five-sixteenths and gave way. LAYLABEN chased the front three to four wide, swung five wide for home and never factored. SWEET N NUTTY midpack under reserve in the two path, spun three wide for home under a drive and tired. ROCK STAR ROYALTY well placed in the two path in close pursuit, remained prominent for three-quarters and stopped.
