CAVIAR N CHAMPAGNE bobbled at the break, assumed a forward position nonetheless, stalked the pacesetter from the outside, ranged up coming to the quarter pole and bid in earnest, left the eighth pole with a slim advantage, added to it, kept busy to the end. UNION BOSS established control under her own power, rider atop with a snug grip on the reins, proved ratable, setting the splits from near the inside on a loosely-contested lead during the opening half, faced some pressure for the first time nearing the quarter pole and got called upon, relinquished before completing the run through the furlong grounds, was still second best. GLYNISTHEMENCE tracked the leader from the inside, came up empty for the stretch drive. ASHCRAFT SILVER underwent a three wide pursuit, kept pace for a half before backing away. MON ROSE four wide departing the backstretch, was guided inward, making it over to the rail by the five-sixteenths pole, was under encouragement cutting the corner into the stretch, had no impact. JULIE'S INA FRENZY was steadied after coming inward at the break, tucked along the rail at the nine-sixteenths pole, took the inside route around the turn, was angled out for the stretch drive, had no offering to render.
