Footnotes

ARGUMENT'S SAKE out on the track well before the abbreviated post parade appeared, came out of the starting gate with no apparent mishap, lagged behind near the back of the pack, unhurried for nearly a half, picked up interest late on the turn and fanned outward for the stretch drive, settled into about the six path in upper stretch and took off in earnest after the front runners, went by them all departing the furlong grounds and drew clear. OUTLAW CODY Z tucked along the inside, saved ground until the quarter pole, gained ground readily during the run through the furlong grounds, needed to split rivals to continue the bid and did so in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, flashed good late foot, but had to settle for the place. SWEET MOON broke open the gate prior to the start, was reloaded without incident and proceeded to lunge when the field was sent off and running, was briskly hand urged to secure a forward position, was three wide at the half mile pole, stayed within range on the turn, got let out nearing the quarter pole and challenged for command, kept up the

pursuit for an additional furlong before flattening out slightly in the last eighth. BRIDGETTA chased three wide and weakened. FIRST FACE raced along the outside and displayed a mild stretch response. FLY CAT off the inside and roused by the five-sixteenths pole, went on to improve position. INQUIRING left alertly and went on to grab the early lead, cut the pace from the inside, lightly coaxed along while doing so, came under intensified pressure late on the turn and soon got called upon, held on stubbornly from upper to midstretch, yielded past the eighth pole and steadily tired. LOBLOLLY PINE in midpack from off the inside, had no rally. CARDIAC RHYTHM took the inside route, launched a menacing rail run from the top of the stretch to loom a threat by the furlong marker, wound up boxed in tight quarters coming to the sixteenth pole, with a full of run PERSKY'S HEART blocking access to the outside at a critical point, was checked and never regained interest. JOY RISING broke outward slightly, making light contact with the nearest opponent, went on to grab a forward post, pressed the issue from the outside until the furlong grounds before backing away. CARPI CLEMENTS departed the backstretch from the four path, was through after completing a half. TATI displayed brief foot. TOUGH TALK stopped and was eased.
