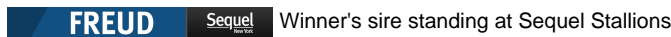

**Footnotes**

SLEEPY FREUD three to four wide in close pursuit of the front, was let out at the quarter pole, confronted the leader with a pair to his inside coming to the final furlong, overhauled the leader at that juncture and kicked clear under a drive. DREAMSGONEWILD well placed in behind the front initially in the two path, maneuvered slightly in at the half mile pole, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into the lane placed to a drive, rallied down along the rail with good energy en route to the place honors. IRISH HUMOR pressed the pace from the three path, was let out nearing the head of the lane, confronted the leader with a pair at the eighth pole, got out kicked through the final sixteenth while safely garnering the show. CALL UP THE CHIEF saved ground towards the rear, angled out five wide at the quarter pole, rallied mildly for the last major share. NORTHERN TRIPP down along the hedge in midpack, was taken in hand briefly just past the half mile pole when STONE PICKER steadied in tight, angled out four wide at the top of the stretch under a drive and made no late headway. SENIOR STATESMAN raced four wide towards the rear, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, swung widest of all six wide for home and made no impact. OLD MAN MEESE set the pace just off the inside, was let out at the quarter pole, got overhauled with an eighth to go by a trio and faltered. NORTHERN EVADER chased the front three wide towards the rear, came under urging at the three-eighths pole and offered no response. STONE PICKER rushed up into a forward position down along the hedge, was steadied in tight just past the half mile pole, ended up getting lightly jostled between rivals soon after as he was taken up briefly, lost ground and position as a result and offered little when called upon. WINNING PAL reluctant to load, seemed to shy from his outside rival sharply after the break and unseated his rider. There was a Stewards' Inquiry into the start before the race was declared official.
