SUPREME SAINT badly outrun early, made a bid while four wide on the turn, took the lead in upper stretch and just hung on. PEACHES N NECTARS stalked the pacesetter early while rank on the first turn, settled in stride nicely while just off the pacemaker on the backstretch, made a bid for the lead on the turn, was asked for her best at the quarter pole and just missed despite drifting out badly in the stretch. IMPULSE SHOPPER showed no speed early, made a bid for the lead while four wide on turn, checked and altered course at the middle of the final turn, had to alter course again in midstretch and finished with good interest. SMOOTH BLUES chased the leaders while along the rail, lacked running room on the rail on the turn and finished decently when she found running room in midstretch. KATIE'S CURE chased the leaders early, made a run the lead while four wide on the turn, was put to the whip at the midway point of the turn, and flattened out badly late. SCREAMIN THE BLUES was outrun early, was asked for his best on the turn and failed to fire. BEBOP BLUES was outrun early, made a run for the lead while four wide on the turn, brushed with KATIE'S TURN on the far turn, entered the stretch six wide and flattened out badly. DINA'S SONG, attended to the pace while two to three wide early and did not quickened when asked for her best on the turn. BRASSY AMBER set the pace early and faltered badly. NUMBERED TERMS chased the leaders and did not fire on the far turn.
