MOR CHANCES pressed the pace between horses, made a run to challenge at the quarter pole, battled heads apart leaving the furlong marker end edged clear late under steady right hand urging. LAW ENFORCEMENT was reserved early, rapidly closed the gap while saving ground at the quarter pole, battled along the inside a furlong out then yielded grudgingly. MOTOR PATROL set the pace slightly off the rail while being pressured into midstretch and weakened in the final eighth. WOLFSON stalked four wide to the turn then drifted out while tiring in upper stretch. MR. WINDJAMMER never reached contention.
