### Footnotes

CAN SHE DANCE reserved within striking distance along the outside, bided her time between rivals during the run around the second bend, was forced to remain on hold, entrapped behind a wall of rivals approaching the top of the stretch, angled free soon after turning for home, immediately commenced her rally after being asked for run, gobbled up ground readily during the proceeding furlong, took over upon reaching the sixteenth pole and edged away. SIMPLE WESTERN unhurried racing along the hedge under a good hold, moved into contention, cutting the corner, past rivals, loomed a serious factor by upper stretch, took aim at the eighth pole, was outfinished by the top one during the final sixteenth but continued on willingly to procure the place. MY SWEET EMILY sped off in hand leaving the starting gate, showed the way on a loosely-contested lead towards the inside, with the rider trying to keep something in reserve, was put to stronger handling after entering the stretch, remained prominently placed before weakening a bit leaving the sixteenth pole. WISE CHOICE tracked the leader from the inside, slipped outward late on the second turn, lacked the necessary stretch response after being asked. REFINERY FIRE off the inside, was swung six wide into the lane, had no rally. UNTAMED GLORY steadied slightly after breaking outward at the start, underwent a three wide journey and gave way after going three-quarters. G. A. EMPRESS rated stalking, folded after completing six furlongs.
